First Day of Instruction Waiver, pursuant to TEC §25.0811. This waiver allows the district to begin instruction for students before the week in which August 21st falls. For this purpose, Sunday is considered the first day of the week. The school district is required to publish a notice 60 days prior to submitting an application. The notice shall include the intent to apply and the specific date the district intends to begin the first day of instruction for students. The district shall hold a public hearing; and in the waiver application, the district shall include a summary of opinions and any consensus of opinion expressed at the public hearing concerning the beginning date of instruction for students. This waiver is granted for one year and an application is required for each subsequent year. Bolded items must be completed.
