SUMMARY: The District maintains approximately 50 copiers that service all campuses and departments district-wide. The contracts are lease agreements, each for a 60-month term, which include both the copier machine lease and maintenance agreements for supplies, parts, and labor. The District does not have one master contract for all copier leases, instead the lease terms and renewals stagger across numerous years. A detailed list of the existing copier lease agreements is attached. Due to the staggered nature of these lease agreements, the District has utilized cooperative purchasing contracts for all renewals in lieu of a formal procurement. At the present time, fifteen copiers districtwide have current lease agreements expiring throughout 2024. Administration requested and received proposals from three local vendors cooperative purchasing contracts. All proposals were evaluated and scored based on pricing. DISTRICT PRIORITIES:
