VATRE Voter Approval Tax Rate Election

What is a VATRE?

A VATRE allows voters to decide whether to increase the governing entity's M&O property tax rate, thereby increasing property tax revenues to be used for the entity's maintenance and operations. The election requires a majority vote to adopt the increased M&O rate.

Goal: Generate more Tax Revenue without impacting SSAISD property owners.

Current Rate .6969 M&O + .4990 I&S = 1.1959 / 100 PV With Successful VATRE Rate .7700 M&O + .4259 I&S = 1.959 / 100 PV

Provides estimated 3 - 4 million per year in additional revenue for District Operations.
