



2025 Board Self Appraisal Results

A self-appraisal survey was completed by 89% of the board members, eight out of nine ISD 917 School Board members between 12/10/25 and 1/5/26.


To what extent do you agree the ISD 917 school board fully embraces and enacts each of our district core values?

➤ Communication & Information Sharing

- Regular, transparent updates and data help board members feel informed, supported, and aligned with the district mission.
- Weekly reports, proactive outreach, and use of Boardbook are highly valued and should continue.

➤ Board Learning & Development

- Board members would benefit from ongoing development through real-time demonstrations, staff presentations, and focused discussions on core values.
- Strong onboarding and orientation for new members supports effectiveness and alignment.

➤ **Meeting Structure & Effectiveness**

- Work sessions and regular board meetings are viewed as efficient, well-structured, and effective.
- The current format, facilitation, and flow from work session to business meeting should continue.

➤ **Collaboration & Alignment**

- More discussion of student and family experiences, district strengths and challenges, and shared goal alignment across home districts and ISD 917 would strengthen collaboration.
- Encouraging thoughtful questions and open dialogue supports better decision-making.

➤ **Operational Improvements (Minor)**

- Few changes were suggested, with minor opportunities to reduce printed materials and reconsider food during work sessions.
