This redesigned annual report card issued by the Oregon Department of Education offers a comprehensive picture of what Sheridan AllPrep Academy offers.



However, an Overall State Rating is decreased one level if the school has not reached a participation goals of 94.5% for OAKS testing. Unfortunately, our student participation rates were lower than 94.5% which has affected our state report card. During

the next school year, we will encourage our parents to ensure their students are tested. We are pleased that we received a Level 3 for Academic Growth in Reading. We hope to maintain that growth to bring our student achievement up to standard.


