#1150 1 2 **Prohibition Against Smoking and the Use** 3 Of Tobacco and Cannabis 4 **Smoking Nicotine and Cannabis Use** 5 6 7 The Madison Board of Education ("Board") prohibits smoking of tobacco or tobacco products, including 8 smoking using an electronic nicotine delivery system (e.g., e-cigarettes), electronic cannabis delivery 9 system, or vapor product, within any of its schools, including in any area of a school building, including 10 but not limited to any indoor facility owned or leased or contracted for, and utilized by the Board for the 11 provision of routine or regular preschool, kindergarten, elementary, or secondary education or library 12 services to children, or on the grounds of such school, or at any school-sponsored activity. 13 14 It is the policy of the Board of Education to prevent and The Board further prohibits the use or 15 possession of cannabis, tobacco, cannabis or tobacco products, including chewing tobacco, or, and 16 cannabis or tobacco paraphernalia (together, "cannabis and tobacco products") including electronic 17 nicotine delivery systems or vapor products in any school building, or on any school propertygrounds, 18 and at school-sponsored activities at any time. Tobacco and tobacco products Cannabis and tobacco 19 products include, but are not limited to cigarettes, cigars, snuff, bidis, smoking tobacco, smokeless 20 tobacco, vapor products, electronic nicotine and cannabis deliverying devices, chemicals, or devices that, 21 when used, produce the same flavor or physical effect of nicotine substances; and any other tobacco, -or 22 nicotine, or cannabis innovations. 23 24 The Board further prohibits the possession, sale or use of alcohol in any area of a school building, on 25 school property, and at school-sponsored activities by any individual at any time. 26 27 Members of the community who fail to comply with this policy may be required to leave school property 28 and may be referred to the police. Students or employees who fail to comply with this policy, or other 29 relevant policies, may face discipline up to and including expulsion or termination and may be referred to 30 the police, as appropriate. 31 The Board further prohibits smoking including smoking using an electronic nicotine delivery system 32 33 (e.g., e-cigarettes) electronic cannabis delivery system, or vapor product on the school property of any 34 administrative office building. 35
