SUMMARY: The DJ-Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) is the leading source of federal justice funding to state and local jurisdictions. The program provides states and local governments with critical funding to support a range of program areas including law enforcement. With the change in Superintendent, the District is updating the authorized official for the grant to the Calallen ISD Chief of Police.
