* To apply for Pre-K, the child must be 4 years of age on or before September 1, 2025.

**Currently enrolled 3-year-olds must requalify for the new school year.

To be eligible for Pre-K, the child must meet at least one of the following criteria:

- 1. The child qualifies for the BISD English as a Second Language Program (assessment administered by district staff); or
- 2. The child is currently or has ever been in the care of DFPS (form 2085 required); or
- 3. The family has lost housing due to economic hardship; or
- 4. The child is military dependent (Department of Defense ID or Statement of Service required); or
- 5. The child qualifies for Medicaid, TANF, or SNAP benefits (current EDG letter required); or
- 6. The family meets income guidelines based on the number of people in the household. Acceptable documentation includes:
 - a. Pay stubs for all wage-earners in the household for the previous month, or
 - b. Income tax returns for 2024.
- 7. The child is a dependent of an eligible recipient of the Star of Texas Award (First Responder injured or kill in the line of duty)
