BUILDINGS/GROUNDS

Facilities Committee

The Facilities Committee met on August 3, 2021, I have attached the minutes.

Washington School Driveway

The driveway is finished and it was built to the approved plan. The City has also finished their part by fixing the ditch and putting a new crown in the road. We have had a lot of heavy rains this year and we noticed that the water runoff was starting to undercut the new concrete we poured. Myself, City Engineer, Greg Holthaus and City worker, Chris Dressen determined that we should add a small section of concrete to stop the rain from destroying the new drive. The extra cost was \$1,330.00.

Gym Floor

I have talked with Kiefer USA, they will be putting the new floor in the all purpose room. They have had numerous employees sick with Covid back in May and June and have fallen behind on schedules. We are not set for the week of September 20th. They have told me they will send a larger crew and will do their best to have this project completed within 7 – 10 days. I have spoken with Adam and he says that date will work with sports and coaches.

Buildings

All buildings are cleaned and ready for the 1st day of school. We plan to keep the same cleaning schedules as we had last year. I plan to use the Clorox Machines as much as possible in the evenings but with limited staff and subs it will be hard to do every night.
