

SUBJECT:	Consideration and possible approval of the Campus Comprehensive Support and Improvement Plans for the 2025-2026 school year.
BACKGROUND:	Under federal accountability requirements, campuses identified for Comprehensive Support and Improvement, as well as those awarded the 2024–2026 Effective Schools Framework (ESF) Focused Support Grant, must develop targeted plans to improve student outcomes. Instructional Leadership Teams (ILTs) at South Houston Elementary and Young Elementary, in partnership with Region 4, conducted an ESF Diagnostic to assess instructional systems and inform plan development.
