Ordinance

Whereas, the Jacksonville Independent School District Board of Trustees is required to adopt a tax rate for the 2017-2018 school year;

Now therefore be it resolved by the Board of Trustees of the Jacksonville Independent School District, County of Cherokee, State of Texas,

That on this date, we, hereby levy or set the tax rate on \$100 valuation for the District for the tax year 2017 at a total tax rate of \$1.4650, to be assessed and collected by the duly specified assessor and collector as follows:

1.04 for Maintenance and Operations; and
.425 for Debt Service

THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE.

There is by this ordinance granted to Cherokee County Appraisal District the right to assess and collect taxes at the rate set herein on real property contained within the Jacksonville Independent School District of Cherokee County, State of Texas.
