There are several changes so far for next school year. We are getting a new portable and moving Camp Sunrise into one of the classrooms. At this time we are leaving the other room open so we have options if numbers go up in another grade level. We have a new teacher for 2nd grade that will be moving into the old portable and our 1/2 blend classroom will be changed to a 1st grade class only.

We will have a 4/5 blend next year to make sure the numbers stay lower at that grade level.

Camp Sunrise is a pilot for an on-line star course which will be specific for each student in that class since there are different grade levels.

We are adding Mystery Science for all grades as a supplement for our science program.
