Mrs. Morrell shared a local area Boys Scout Council Leadership video presentation with the 1st and 2nd Grade students on September 22nd. A brief overview of the scouting program in Pana was presented, and was followed up by an evening time informational meeting for parents.

The Tiered Level Intervention benchmarking sweep using MAP was completed the week of August 24th. All in-person AND remote students were tested in reading and math during the sweep. The children were extremely cooperative during the testing period and did an excellent job demonstrating their skill level. The data collected has been used to create individualized programs targeted at addressing the specific skill deficits of our children. Researched based interventions have begun, and another year of learning is under way.

The PREP/EC classrooms are currently delivering their services remotely. Like the other classrooms in the building, they are hosting google meetings, videotaping activities, reading to students, and doing assessments.

Mrs. Holthaus has replaced Mrs. Denning as the Parent Program (Smart Buddies) Coordinator. A whole new era has begun with the program in the age of Covid-19 and the big buddies have received their informational packets. The SMART Buddy program promotes learning for students by matching them with a big buddy who works with them weekly and helps to celebrate their accomplishments. This worthwhile program has grown every year and continues to provide wonderful learning partners to children. Being creative and finding new ways to connect to students is the task at hand!
