It is definitely understood that in case of a conflict among the prices quoted for any item in the Bid Form on the foregoing pages, the unit price shall govern.

Time is of the essence. The undersigned bidder agrees to begin work within fourteen (14) calendar days following a written Notice to Proceed to be and substantially complete within 120 calendar days following the start time; provided, however, that the OWNER'S construction funds are available.

Enclosed with this Bid is a Bidder's Bond or Cashier's Check for 5% of total bid including alternates. (\$ _____) dollars, which it is agreed shall be collected and retained by the OWNER as liquidated damages if the OWNER accepts this bid within sixty (60) days after the opening of bids, and the undersigned bidder then fails to execute the contract and bonds with the said OWNER within ten (10) days after official notice of such acceptance; otherwise, said Bidder's Bond or Check shall be returned to the undersigned on demand. This sum of money is not to be considered as a penalty, but shall be deemed, taken and treated as reasonable liquidated damages. The sum of money is fixed and agreed on between the bidder and owner because of the impracticability and extreme difficulty of fixing and ascertaining the actual damage to the OWNER.
