Expectations for a Privately Funded Pana Jr. High Baseball and Softball Program

- Entire Programs would be COMPLETELY funded through private contributions (i.e. start-up, coaching salaries, equipment, supplies, officials, uniforms, entry fees, score keepers, transportation, IESA dues, and any other expenses incurred by the district for the programs to operate.)
- 2. School District would maintain 100% control over the programs.
- 3. Funding would have to be raised up front each year.
- 4. Total transparency with regards to funds and fund raising. Including the submittal of an annual budget.
- 5. Pana Jr. High Baseball/Softball Organization is to include District representation and transparency with their meetings.
- 6. Pana Jr. High Baseball/Softball Organization responsible for field preparation at Tanner Park, Pana Park, Pana HS or other fields used for games and practice.
- 7. Programs must maintain a minimum of 15 players. If numbers fall below 15 the programs will no longer be viable and will be ended by the District.
- 8. If any deadlines are missed for paying program bills the program will be disbanded by the District.
