AGENDA ITEM: Consider Approval of 2018-2019 District Improvement Plan (DIP)

Background Information:

On an annual basis, the district is required to develop a District Improvement Plan (DIP). This process is completed by developing a Comprehensive Needs Assessment (CNA) based on an extensive data review and then the Campus Improvement Plan (CIP) goals are aligned to address the needs identified. This review process began in July at our Bearcat Leadership Team (BLT) meeting. The District instructional focus was developed and three major areas of need were identified. All campus and district goals are now aligned to address and focus actions for improvement in these areas.

Administrative Considerations:

The District utilizes the District Improvement Committee (DWEIC) which is made up of parents, community members, and elected staff members to develop and review the Comprehensive Needs Assessment. The District Improvement Plan is then revisited throughout the school year to track the progress for each identified strategy and goal.

FISCAL NOTE:
