**FINAL ORDER**

This cause comes to be heard on the Illinois Department of Public Health's (hereinafter Complainant) Notice of Intent to Assess a Civil Penalty and Notice of Opportunity for Hearing (hereinafter "Notice of Intent"). The undersigned, having reviewed the record and being fully advised in the premises finds:

1. The Complainant by Notice of Intent (Exhibit A attached) sent on April 5, 2017, by both certified mail and first class mail to Respondent ALL SEASONS PLUMBING & SEWER CORP., notified the Respondent of alleged violations of the Asbestos Abatement Act (105 ILCS 105/1 *et seq.*), the Commercial and Public Building Asbestos Abatement Act (hereinafter Commercial Building Act) (225 ILCS 207/1 *et seq.*) and Code (77 Ill. Adm. Code 855); and that Complainant intended to Assess a Civil Penalty of Sixteen Thousand Dollars (\$16,000.00) and that the Respondent had fifteen (15) days from the date of mailing of said notice to request a hearing.
2. Respondent or its registered agent failed to pick up the certified mail as evidenced by Exhibit B attached hereto. The regular mail to Respondent's registered agent was not returned to the

Department and therefore was received by the Respondent's registered agent.

3. Respondent failed to request a hearing within fifteen (15) days of the date of mailing as required by Section 6(c) of the Asbestos Act.

**WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

- A. The Complainant's Notice of Intent to Assess Civil Penalty dated March 28, 2017 is hereby affirmed.
- B. The Respondent is assessed a civil penalty of Sixteen Thousand Dollars (\$16,000.00). Respondent shall remit payment to "Illinois Department of Public Health" along with a copy of this Final Order to the Illinois Department of Public Health, P.O. Box 4263, Springfield, Illinois 62708.
- C. This Final Order is subject to judicial review pursuant to the provisions of the Administrative Review Law, (735 ILCS 5/3-101 *et seq.*).
