### **BUILDINGS/GROUNDS**

#### **Facilities Committee**

The committee did not meet. Next meeting is May, 12 at 5:30 PM in the Unit Office Board Room.

#### **Mower Purchase**

I replaced one of our mowers for the Maintenance staff with a new one from Outdoor Power Source here in town. The one I replaced had 4178 hours on it and needed \$4000.00 dollars to repair it. The cost of the new mower was \$10,400.

#### **Football Field Lights**

We had lightning strike a light pole on the football field causing damage to five lights, sound system wiring and the amplifier. I have everything fixed and have filed a claim with our insurance company. Damages were around \$7500.00.

#### **High School Roof Repair**

All the repairs to the roof have been completed. The repairs were completed prior to an inch and a half of rain and we saw no leaks. The next step will be to coat the entire roof with a clear sealer and then that roof should in good condition for the future.

#### **Multi -Purpose Gym Floor**

The floor is slated to start August 1<sup>st</sup>. If materials arrive sooner, then we may get started the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of July. I have attached a photo of what the floor will look like when they are finished.

#### **Track Repair**

We have noticed that there are areas on the track that are starting to separate from the asphalt. I reached out to Byrne & Jones about getting these areas repaired and they came this morning, Monday the 26<sup>th</sup>, to make the repairs. The reason they gave me was from water sitting between the track surface and the asphalt and freezing.
