<u>Audit Presentation</u> Luke Greden from CliftonLarsonAllen LLP will be presenting the results of our FY25 Audit. Thank you very much to Business Manager Julie Grant who has been working with Luke and his team on the audit since July. We can be pleased to see the increase in our unreserved fund balance though we know this needs to continue to be an important focus for the district.

These were also discussed with the Systems Accountability Committee (one edit suggestion) and the District Policy Review Committee. We are also working on a proposed updated logo.
