# Why Summer Learning?

- Provide a system that supports the whole child
- Give access to a tiered instruction and support in academics.
- Create schools and classrooms that are safe and welcoming
- Reteach and pre-teach specific skills for students to be successful

# How is Summer Learning Possible?

Lakeville Area Schools has a state approved Area Learning Center. This allows for:

- State Funding for Targeted Service summer and school year
- State Funding for Credit Recovery summer and School year
- All students must qualify under [MN Statute 124D.8](#)



# Programming Schedule

- Programming is in the mornings for the months of June and July
- Number of days per week and length of days is developmentally appropriate for the age of the students
- No programming on Fridays to allow families long weekends for summer plans



# Program Enhancements

- Extra enrichment week for grades 1-8 (optional and week before July 4)
- Credit recovery for 15 year olds - separate room with licensed teachers
- Continue to collaborate with SPED in IEP process for summer programming
- Collaborate with Continuous Improvement Department to offer Step up Week for incoming 9th graders next summer

- Designed for each student specifically with digital curriculum and Ipads

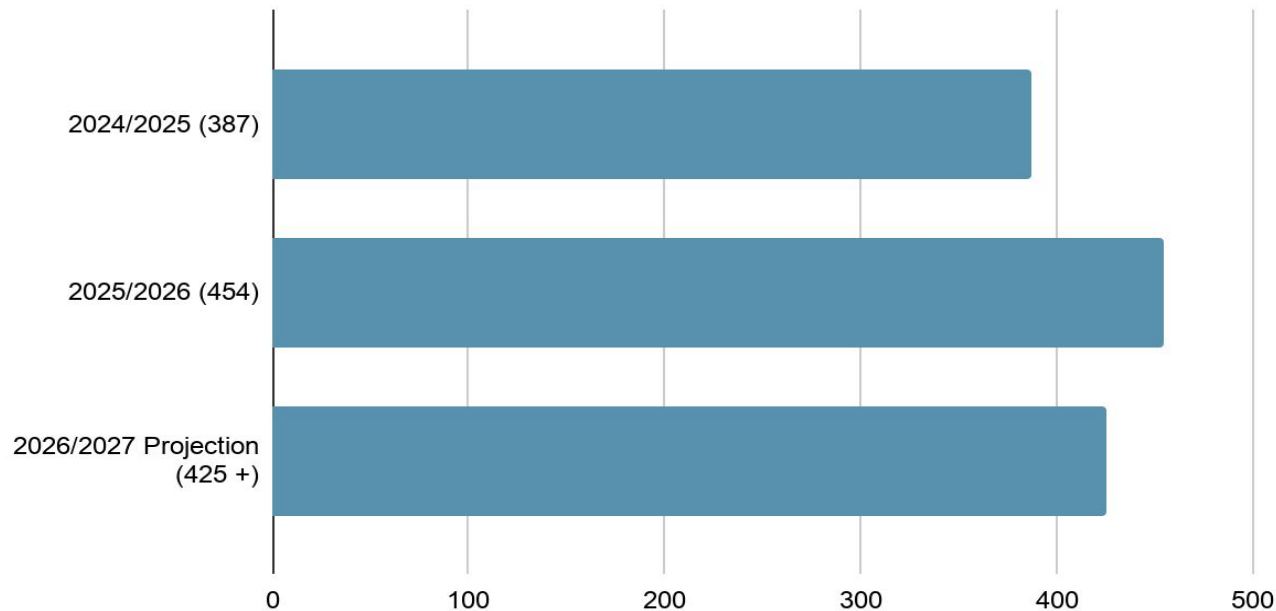

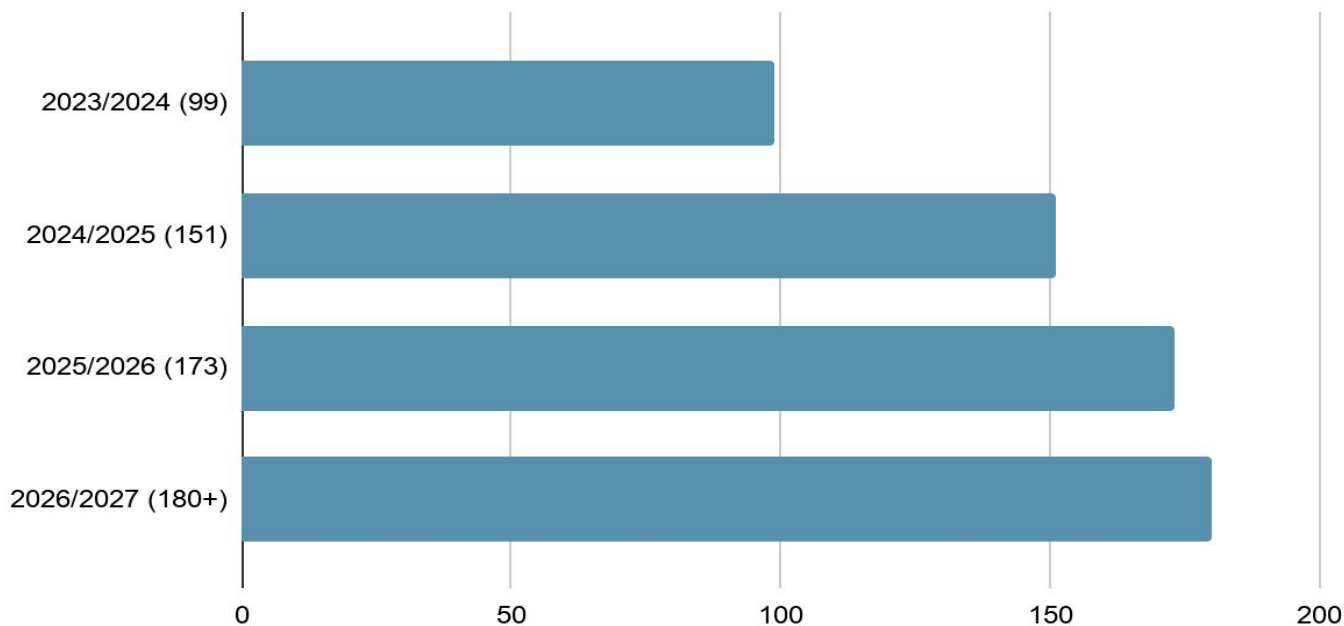

Targeted Services Student Enrollment



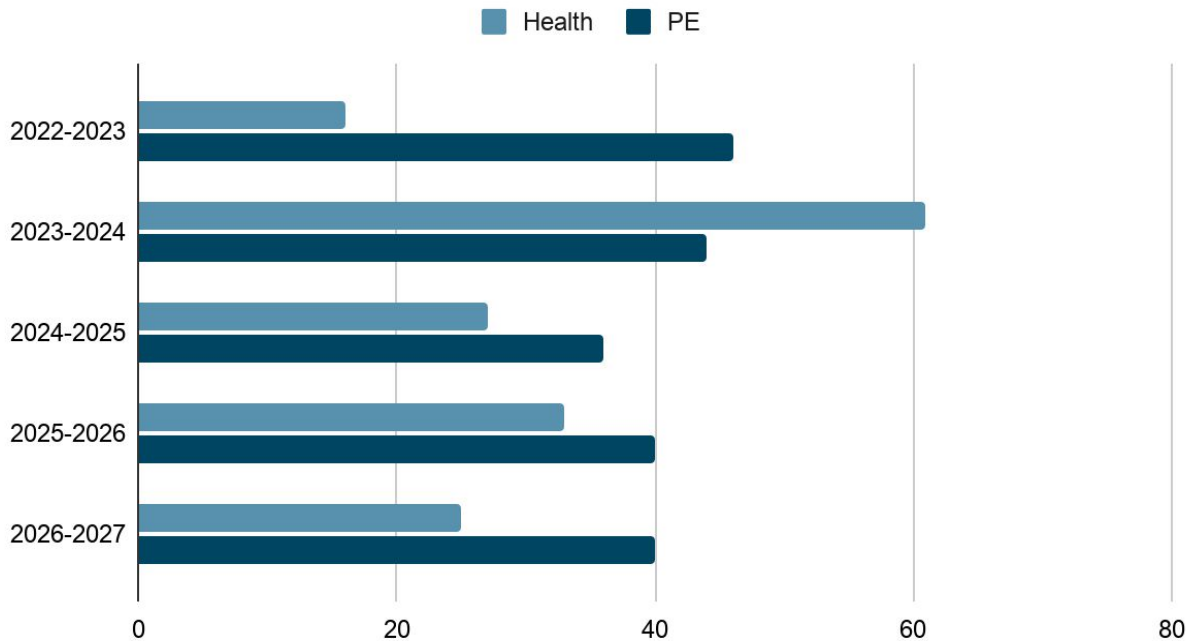
# Summer Academic Programs

Credit Recovery Student Enrollment



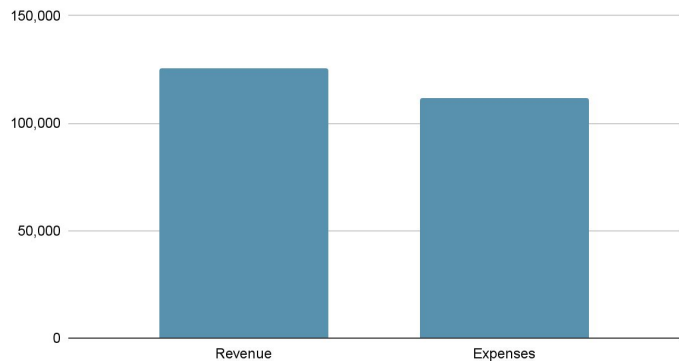
# Summer Academic Programs

Online Tuition Based Student Enrollment

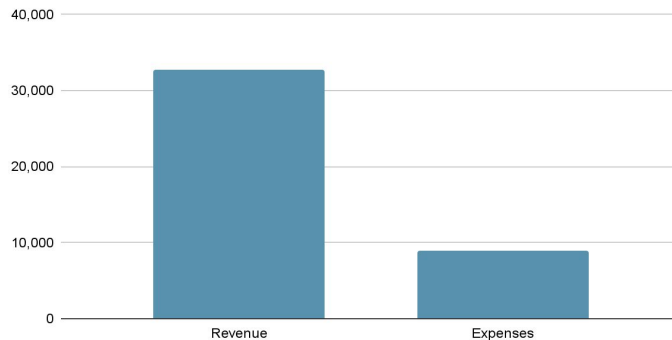

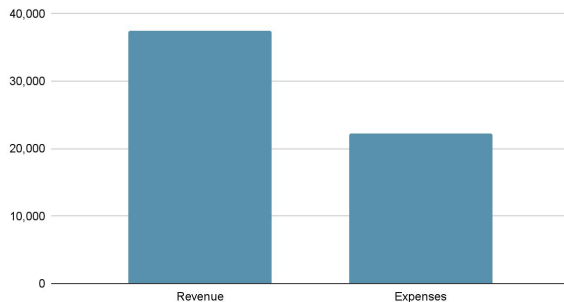

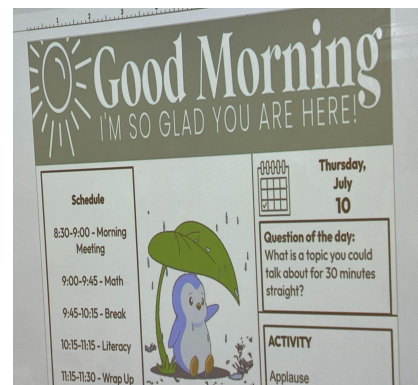


# Goals for the 2026-27 school year

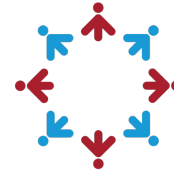

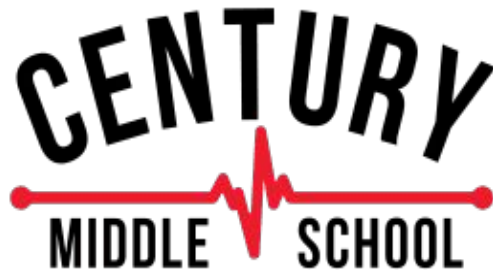
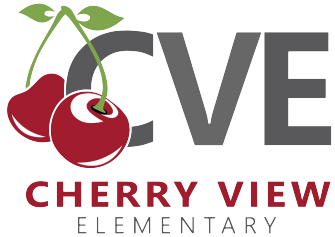
