- Jacket Dads: The Jacket Dads have agreed to host a Father/Daughter dance on December 18, 2014. The Father/Daughter dance will serve as a fundraiser for Jacket Dad efforts throughout the year.
- **Mileage Club**: Students have walked more than 4,400 miles and will make it to Anchorage, Alaska before Christmas. Coach Wyman has put a survey on her website to plan for the next destination.
- **TerraCycle**: Four students presented the TerraCycle project to the entire student body. Each student advocated for a particular humanitarian cause and students voted to see which one the school would support. The students decided that we would use our points to help feed 166 hungry Americans.
- **Reading and Writing support from Region VII**: Ms. Johnston affirmed our progress in the Daily 5 implementation. Ms. Johnston noted the following practices:
