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


### 2023-2024 Summary - Highlights

#### During the 2023-2024 school year:

- Average daily attendance rate was at 93.7%
- 58% of our students K-4 met their projected growth in Math on MAP
- 39% of our students K-4 met their projected growth in Reading on MAP
- 3rd grade EL students had average Reading proficiency level of 3.5
- 75% of EL students made overall growth in their composite proficiency level

## Goal # 1 Educational Equity

By May of 2025, Beaupre will decrease office discipline referrals by 10% from the 23-24 school year.

- Ensure staff understand Tier I instruction and resources, as well as Tier II and Tier III
- Launch school-wide teaching of behavior expectations and routines with a reboot in January
- Second STEP Curriculum following the Behavior Campaign Plan
- Reinforce PBIS with expectations and incentives



## Goal # 2 Operational Excellence

By May 2025, Beaupre will maintain a cumulative monthly average daily attendance rate of 95% for the 2024-2025 school year.

- Utilization of ROE Truancy officer

### Goal # 4 Student Achievement
