January Teacher Tip

Best way to submit Work Samples:

The best way to keep work samples in one place and email them easily is to have an app/program that saves files together in one folder.

The Genius Scan App is the best one I've found yet. You can label a folder (student name & Semester?) and then continue to add work samples as the semester goes along. I usually add to the title as I add work samples, so I know what is in each folder quickly. When I get a science work sample, I add to the title (science 1) so I know I have one sample and still need one more. When I add the 2nd science sample, I change the 1 to a 2 and move on knowing I have all of science covered. When I get to the end of the semester, I check through my folder to see what I still need to add, get them added and then email it to my teacher as one folder.

What work samples are needed based on type of curriculum

Book curriculum – 2 graded pages per subject. This is usually tests or Lesson pages. Please make sure to put a score/grade, student name and the subject for the sample (science, math, etc.)

Online curriculum – Progress report showing at least 50% of class is completed. If they have not completed at least 50% of

the class, please go ahead and email the report and let your teacher know the plan to help your student catch up.

PE/Music/Family and Consumer Science (Home Ec., Life Skills, etc.) – A Class Progress Log (CPL) for each individual class logging all hours in the semester.

Art – 2 Graded pictures of Artwork done by the student during that semester
