TOPIC: Approval to Purchase Chromebooks for LCTC – CTE 61a Added Cost Funds

RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District approve the purchase of 90 Dell Chromebooks and three carts from Presidio, for a total cost of \$32,703.
