Reference: Recommendation for inmate food service 5 year contract

The Alpena County Sheriff's Office received 5 bids for inmate food service. Bids came from Waho's Country Catering (current provider), Canteen Services, Kellwell, Summit and Trinity. Bids were required to provide a 5 year contract, list how they can fulfill the needs of the facility, maintain qualified and trained staff, provide a 30 day menu, have said menu reviewed by a dietitian, outline special diet menu modifications, supply sufficient information on the project requirements, provide for a minimum 2500 calorie per day menu and indicate a price per meal.

Attached to this memorandum is a proposal breakdown on how each bidder met or did not meet the request for proposal along with a price per meal based on 58 inmates.

The Alpena County Sheriff's Office is recommending that we accept the bid from Canteen Services at a price per meal of \$2.55. Additional factors that were considered with this recommendation are as follows. Canteen services practices a knife free kitchen. This promotes safety for the staff and inmates alike. They have an on staff dietitian to ensure all menus and substitutions meet established caloric requirements. Canteen services has structured inspection requirements that happen daily, weekly, monthly and quarterly. Inmate workers will also be trained in the kitchen with opportunity to become Serve Safe certified which will help them be employed once released from custody.

Accepting bids during the September meeting will allow for us to budget for next year as well as give notice to our current inmate meal provided that our contract will not be renewed.
