Summary: The Intruder Detection Audit (IDA) process is designed to evaluate the safety and security of campuses based on a set of physical and procedural criteria, developed in coordination with the Texas School Safety Center (TxSSC) as required by TEC, §37.1084.

A Detection Audit was conducted by the Texas School Safety Center (TxSSC) and any corrective action plans if needed, were put into place. Notice of this audit and correction plan is to meet the requirements of the Governor of Texas and TxSSC.

Rationale: Maintaining safe and secure learning environments is an ongoing process. Trainings regularly take place at each campus.
