Purpose of Report

Objectives

- Provide opportunities for academic enrichment for identified students
- Offer students a broad array of additional services, programs and activities
- Offer families of these students services and support

Operational Impact

- Serve the following campuses: Evers Elementary, Hodge Elementary, Lee Elementary, Newton Rayzor Elementary, Calhoun Middle School, Navo Middle School, Strickland Middle School, and Denton High School
- 5 year funding from this federal grant (details in attached powerpoint) with Denton ISD supplementing in the last 2 years
- Personnel: Program Coordinator, 8 Site Coordinators, 5 Academic Enrichment Specialists per site
- Grant was submitted April 17, 2008 and participants will be notified in August as to whether or not it has been awarded. If awarded the program will begin immediately.

- Will be monitored by outside evaluator
- Provide at-risk students with additional academic support
- Grant monitors progress in the following areas: academics, TAKS, discipline, attendance, college readiness
