I would like to ask for permission for myself to travel to Vancouver, WA and participate in a PBIS training with a Tier 2 focus on 10/3-10/4/17. I have planned to review the PowerPoint, conduct a TFI (Tier Fidelity Inventory for Tier 2), and put in place support programs for our yellow zone kids.
