Night High School Mission

To provide flexible school hours in the evening with additional support and interventions to 9th-12th grade LISD students at the Lewisville Learning Center to increase:

- Successful course completion
- High school graduation, and
- Transition to post-secondary education and/or career of choice

Optional Flexible School Day Program Components (OFSDP)

- Students in 9th-12th grade meeting TEA criteria for at-risk and dropouts are eligible to participate.
- Eligible for pro-rated WADA funding based on minutes in attendance for at-risk students (minimum 45 contiguous min/week)
- Offer core and elective courses
- Students are required to take and pass all state tests in order to graduate.
- Utilize case management approach, including outreach, social service and community referrals to increase student academic success and graduation from high school
- The program was originally implemented in 2009-2010

NHS 0.5 Credits Earned by Content Area

- The data below signifies how many students were enrolled by content each 4 ½ week term to earn a half credit.
- Please note that Night High School teachers taught a 3rd period class which is not reflected in these numbers since only LLC Accelerated High School students are enrolled.


2024-2025 Evaluation Data (combo)

- Three Class Periods, Monday Friday from 2:05 PM 7:20 PM
- Faculty & Staff include 4 core teachers, 1 counselor shared with LLC Middle School, 1 administrative assistant, 1 part-time nurse, 1 administrator shared with LLC, 2 part-time ESL teachers, 2 part-time SPED teachers and 11 adjunct teachers.
- Average of 54 students in each of the eight terms.
- 28 Recovered Dropouts, 140 Dual-Enrolled Students, 215 Night High School only, 14 Online Classes offered, Average of 20 free dinners per night.
- Total of 44 Graduates
- 11 Students continuing enrollment into 2025-2026
- One of the recommendations was to continue to submit the OFSDP application and offer Night HS through LLC.

Enrollment & Graduation Data

Over the past 6 years,

- 236 LISD students have graduated
- 92% graduation rate
- Average of 54 students in each of the eight terms



Enrollment, Outreach, & Graduation

Enrollment 2024 - 2025

- Served 215 Night School Students
- Served 140 Part-Time Students enrolled full time at their home campus
- Remediation or Advancement
- Average of 54 students each of the eight terms.

Outreach 2024 – 2025

- Teachers made 606 phone calls & sent 328 emails
- 28 New Night School Students enrolled due to outreach this year.
