## TRANSPORTATION MANAGEMENT STUDENT TRANSPORTATION

ELIGIBILITY	The District shall provide transportation for any student who meets the eligibility requirements established under $\underline{\text{TEC}}$ <u>Education Code</u> 25.155 and under the District desegregation plan approved by the U.S. District Court, Western District of Texas. An exception to the eligibility requirements may be made by the Superintendent or designee when transportation is requested for a documented medical/hardship condition.
	Any student who voluntarily transfers from his or her assigned school campus to a school campus located in another attendance zone and who does not otherwise qualify under the provisions of either the Education Code or the District desegregation plan is not eligible for District trans- portation.
BUS STOPS	All students who use District transportation shall board buses at autho- rized stops. Authorized bus stops shall be designated annually by the Su- perintendent or designee. Bus drivers shall load and unload passengers only at authorized stops.
SAFETY PRECAUTIONS	Safety precautions shall be exercised in bus operations at all times. If at any time the bus driver is uncertain about road or vehicle conditions, or other safety factors, the driver shall park the vehicle until safe operating conditions are assured.
