




**SUBJECT:** Spanish/French Immersion Camp at Concordia Language Villages in Bemidji, MN

The D.C. Everest Junior High School is excited to offer the opportunity for students to attend a full immersion Spanish and French camp during the 2026-2027 school year. Students from both the Junior and the Senior high will have the opportunity to attend Concordia Language Village in Bemidji, MN in March 2027. Concordia is the premier immersion camp experience in the country. Students will be immersed in Spanish and French language and culture for the entire weekend. I have attended this camp in the past with students and they can attest that they were transformed by the experience. They saw their communicative and interpretive abilities grow in the language.

The cost for the weekend will be \$370 per student plus approximately \$120-\$150 per student for transportation from school to Bemidji, MN. Jennifer Kindlarski and Beth Bouffleur will accompany students on the trip as well as additional chaperones per Concordia Language Villages policies. Jennifer Kindlarski will coordinate the details of the trip in conjunction with the directors at Concordia Language Villages. Jennifer and Beth will work together to provide fundraising opportunities to offset the cost of the bus. Jennifer and Beth as chaperones will also each qualify for the \$75/night overnight travel stipend.
