Three years ago, we recreated the internship program in all three of our District high schools, targeting both skilled, certified, and qualified Career and Technology Education program completers and students not captured by any other program in Amphitheater. The internship program assured equitable access to all students who wished to serve as an intern.

This program grew exponentially, doubling each year, even during the COVID-19 shut-down. During the redevelopment of the internship program it became evident that our community needed more easily accessible support. This realization took seed and cultivated our plan for the Amphitheater Career Innovation Center to support both students and families within our community.
