RECOMMENDATION:	Approval of Resolution No. R25/26-31, Agreeing to Name the Newly Constructed Natural Resources Center After the Holdens

REASON FOR BOARD CONSIDERATION:

Terry and Cheryl Holden have agreed to pledge \$5,000,000 to secure naming rights to the Clackamas Community College (CCC) Natural Resources Center of Excellence. Per CCC Board Policy FF - Naming of Buildings, it provides the Board authority to name buildings recognizing substantial contributions.

BACKGROUND:

The Holdens have a long-standing history of philanthropy with the CCC Foundation and College. They have provided not only a \$5 million gift in 2021 to name the Holden Industrial Technical Center (ITC), but also many smaller capital projects for our career technical education (CTE) programs over the past 5 years. This commitment further demonstrates their commitment to the College and our career technical programs. This opportunity and commitment provides not just local but statewide impact for CCC.

The College agrees to name the newly constructed Natural Resources Center after Terry and Cheryl Holden, which the official name of the building will be determined in the future, with the agreement to provide a \$5 million donation gift to the CCC Foundation and the College.

BUDGET IMPACT/SOURCE OF FUNDS:

There will be no impact on the College’s budget. This gift and naming agreement will support bond projects approved by the passing of the 2024 bond.
