Denton Independent School District Rooftop Units Replacement for Windle School for Young Children Purchase

SUMMARY:

This item requests approval of the quote from TD Industries in the amount of \$365,615.00 for the replacement and installation of fifteen (15) rooftop units at Windle School for Young Children.

BOARD GOAL:

Growth & Management - Demonstrate effective and efficient management of district resources

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

The Board called for the 2018 bond election with the recommendation by the Bond Committee. On May 5, 2018 the bond was approved by the voters of Denton ISD.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The replacement of fifteen (15) rooftop units at Windle School for Young Children was included in the 2018 Bond Authorization. Fifteen (15) rooftop units will be replaced with this purchase. The total cost of replacing all rooftop units for Windle School for Young Children is \$365,615.00.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

The replacement and installation of the rooftop units will be purchased from TD Industries through a Texas Local Governmental Purchasing Cooperative OMNIA NIPA contract. This purchase is being brought for approval in accordance with the District's CH (local) policy.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

The cost will be borne through the 2018 Bond Authorization.

BENEFIT OF ACTION:

The approval of this purchase will allow the District to order and have the rooftop units installed in time to be ready for the 2020-2021 school year.

SUPERINTENDENT'S RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the quote from TD Industries in the amount of \$365,615.00 for the replacement and installation of fifteen (15) rooftop units at Windle School for Young Children be approved.
