Request for Renewal

After having evaluated the process during the 23-24 school year, we believe that we made a really good start of having a PLC focused process that placed a high regard for student interventions. While we do not have any State mandated testing data, the goal is for the student interventions to be a driving force in increased levels of student growth and achievement. These interventions are needed for those students who did not grasp specific high priority skills and standards. After seeing the successes of interventions being provided on 2 days of the week, we are going to be adding a day so that Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays are used for student intervention/enrichment time for the 24-25 school year. We did notice that our staff was really being pushed too hard to meet the weekly Friday CFA data and entry that went along with it. After the first nine weeks, we made some adjustments in order to allow for the CFA type quick checks to happen more naturally in the teacher's classes. Many of our teachers liked the Friday quick checks/data report and continued to use it all year long. Others were able to make a slight adjustment and it really helped their morale.

Please consider our request to extend our waiver to the 24-25 school year and going forward into the following school years as we continue to build on the PLC process in our school.

- 1. Provide a DETAILED RATIONALE explaining how the waiver will enhance student learning opportunities, promote innovation, or increase equitable access to effective teachers. Include information about the problem or obstacle, if any, the waiver will help the district overcome.
 - As part of the PLC process implementation of our school during the 23-24 school year, the block schedule that we had used in the past was changed to include a "Fast Friday" in which all of our classes meet for 45 minutes. Our new schedule has A days on Monday and Wednesday, B days on Tuesday and Thursday, and then the Fast Friday in which all classes (A and B) meet. Each Monday-Thursday has a 30 minute block of "homeroom/advisory/intervention/enrichment" time from 9:30 am -10:00 am. Fridays do not have that block of time. It is important to note that all teachers stay within the allowed 30 students per teaching block on Monday-Thursday. On the Fast Friday, during the 23-24 school year, we had some teachers who would have gone over the 150 student cap. I will give information about each day below.
 - Monday: Each department holds their PLC Team meetings on Mondays. During this time, information and data that is collected from the Fast Friday classes will be used to determine interventions/enrichments on Wednesday and Thursday. During the homeroom time, students will have Capturing Kids' Hearts (social/emotional learning) lessons.

- Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday: Students will be assigned specific places to go through RTI Scheduler. During the 23-24 school year, we only used Wednesday and Thursday for our intervention/enrichment time. Due to the seen need of more intervention time, I am going to be adding Tuesday as an additional day of interventions. Our teachers will use data when they give Common Formative Assessments to all students. Students who do not meet the stated essential standard or skill for that week will be placed back with their teacher for specific guided interventions so that they can meet proficiency for that standard or skill. All of our core teachers will be placed with students who need those interventions. Students who were at proficiency will be placed with our non-core teachers. They will have specific enrichment activities that they can work with on our students.
- o Friday: This is where we hold the "Fast Friday" in which all classes on the A and B day schedule meet. Classes are 45 minutes each throughout the day. This is a great time for core teachers to give Common Formative Assessments based upon the essential standard or skills that they determined would be the focus for the week with their Department Team meeting on Monday. The data that is collected form these assessments will then be used to start the weekly cycle over again. Due to all classes meeting during the day, we had a handful of teachers during the 23-24 school year who went over the allowable 150 students per day on Friday. We had several others who were really close to going over the 150 student. Again, no teacher has more than the 30 allowable per class.
- 2. Provide a detailed explanation of how the services being waived will be provided for students.
 - With our current block schedule, Blocks 1-3 are A/B days and meet for 90 minutes of instruction time each. Blocks 4 and 5 meet every day and have 45 minutes of instruction time per day. This ensures that all classes have the same number of instructional minutes on Monday-Thursday. Fast Friday allows students to meet with each of their teachers for the Common Formative Assessments for 45 minutes of instruction time per period. The goal of this 45 minute class is to take the CFA and then to try to give additional support for skills and standards that have been taught that week. Teachers are not looking to teach new material on the Friday classes. This time can also be used by the teacher to reteach content again in which they see an overwhelming need after looking at data gained throughout the process.
 - Once the teacher has the CFA data, students will then be given specific locations for interventions/enrichments that they must attend on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. Teachers will draft the students they need to work with by using the RTI Scheduler program. It is a goal to start letting students have a choice in selecting locations they will attend as well for the 24-25 school year. Any teacher that needed a student who had already chosen a place they would like to go can always override the student choice in RTI Scheduler. Students who were not proficient in the skill or standard will have the opportunity to work with their teacher, or another who may teach the same subject matter, to close those learning gaps. Students who have shown to be proficient will be sent to non-core teachers to work on enrichment activities. Any student who is drafted by one of the core teachers due to not meeting a standard or skill in those classes will not go to the enrichment locations. We will also created priority days in which the specific subject (example English) were given priorty on scheduling needed students before any other teacher can select them. We plan to use this time to work on additional things such as:
 - ACT prep
 - AP test prep
 - o Book club
 - o Art enrichment
 - Additional sectional band/choir practices
 - o Additional skill specific work for athletic teams
 - Meeting with seniors to discuss job related skills

- o Meetings with Military recruiters for various grade levels
- o Teacher selected content students find interesting
- State mandated community service time availability
- Student work with counselors/career coach
- 3. Provide a detailed explanation of how the district will monitor and evaluate the effectiveness of the waiver.
 - Each week, Department Teams will meet and discuss the new learning targets to meet with the selected essential skills/standards that week. The principal and assistant principal will be in those meetings when student data is being discussed. Each month, our district level PLC team will meet monthly to share building level data and discuss building level and district level goals. Throughout the school year, the principal and assistant principal will share information with the superintendent regarding successes or improvements that could be made in the schedule to enhance student academic growth. Each week, the principal and assistant principal will oversee the RTI Scheduler program and work with teachers to create their sessions. Once available, state mandated testing data will be collected and evaluated to see what adjustments may need to be made with the intervention/enrichment times and offerings. The overall perceptions of the program will discussed in our District Administration PLC during our team time that will be scheduled as we discuss the upcoming school year. This will be the cycle that is used each year as we continue to monitor and adjust based on what students need.

Westside High School Act 1240 Waiver for Student Learning Opportunities and Schedule Flexibility

WHEREAS, the Westside High School is committed to providing the best possible education for its students, promoting innovation, and ensuring equitable access to effective teaching; and

WHEREAS, the implementation of a block schedule with a "Fast Friday" has been undertaken to enhance student learning, foster innovation, and increase access to effective teaching, as part of the Professional Learning Community (PLC) process; and

WHEREAS, the block schedule includes "A days" on Monday and Wednesday, "B days" on Tuesday and Thursday, and a "Fast Friday" with all classes meeting for 45 minutes; and

WHEREAS, a 30-minute block of homeroom/advisory/intervention/enrichment time is allocated from 9:30 am - 10:00 am on Monday-Thursday; and

WHEREAS, it has been observed that during "Fast Friday," some teachers may exceed the 150 student cap set for the day by Arkansas state standards, albeit not exceeding the 30 students per class limit; and

WHEREAS, the school district recognizes the importance of Special Education co-teaching initiatives to ensure compliance with Universal Design for Learning (UDL) and to meet the diverse needs of students; and

WHEREAS, the district aims to provide targeted interventions for students who need additional support and enrichment activities for those who have demonstrated proficiency; and

WHEREAS, the district is dedicated to monitoring and evaluating the effectiveness of the waiver to ensure continuous improvement in student academic growth;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Westside Consolidated School Board approves the request to petition the Arkansas State Board of Education to renew the Act 1240 waiver for student learning opportunities and schedule flexibility, as outlined below:

- 1. Rationale and Problem Addressed: The "Fast Friday" schedule and associated homeroom/advisory/intervention/enrichment time have been implemented to address the need for targeted interventions and enrichment opportunities. This schedule allows for data-driven interventions based on Common Formative Assessments, benefiting both struggling students and those who have achieved proficiency. While some teachers may exceed the 150 student cap on "Fast Friday," this resolution aims to address this situation by acknowledging the unique circumstances of co-teaching Special Education classes and the overall benefits of the schedule.
- **2. Services Provided:** The schedule structure ensures equitable instructional time for all classes. The "Fast Friday" classes focus on giving and reviewing Common Formative Assessments that will be used to provide additional support or enrichment based on student needs. The RTI Scheduler program is used to allocate students to interventions or enrichments on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. Core teachers provide targeted interventions, while non-core teachers offer enrichment activities. Priority scheduling days will further enhance the effectiveness of these interventions and enrichments.
- 3. Monitoring and Evaluation: Westside High School Department Teams will meet weekly to assess learning targets and student data. The principal, assistant principal, and district-level PLC team will collaborate monthly to discuss building and district-level goals, academic growth, and program effectiveness. The superintendent will receive updates on successes and recommendations for improvements. After the first year and once available, state-mandated testing data will be analyzed to refine intervention and enrichment strategies. District-wide perceptions of the program will be discussed in the District Administration PLC, ensuring a continuous cycle of monitoring and adjustment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this waiver and schedule flexibility will be implemented for the upcoming academic year and moving forward, with the understanding that ongoing assessment and adjustments will be made to optimize student learning opportunities, innovation, and equitable access to effective teaching.



To All Westside High School Stakeholders,



I am writing on behalf of Westside High School to inform you of our intent to re-apply for a waiver under ACT 1240 regarding teacher load. As a valued stakeholder in the education community, we believe it is essential to keep you informed about our efforts to enhance the educational experience for our students. ACT 1240, designed to provide flexibility in educational regulations, allows schools to apply for waivers in specific areas to better meet the unique needs of their student body and ensure quality education. In light of our commitment to delivering the best possible education to our students, last year, Westside High School modified our typical block schedule that has been used in years past. That change was made to positively impact our students' educational experience and promote innovation in our teaching methods.

Westside High School is dedicated to providing the highest quality education for our students while ensuring that every student has access to effective teaching. In alignment with these goals, we will be petitioning the Arkansas State Board of Education to use the slightly modified block schedule that includes a designated "Fast Friday." This initiative is part of our ongoing commitment to Professional Learning Communities (PLCs) and aims to enhance student learning, encourage innovation, and increase equitable access to effective teaching for all students.

During the 2023-2024 school year, our block schedule consisted of A days on Monday and Wednesday, B days on Tuesday and Thursday, and a "Fast Friday" where all classes met for 45 minutes. Additionally, a 30-minute block of homeroom/advisory/intervention/enrichment time was allocated from 9:30 am - 10:00 am on Monday-Thursday. This structure was strategically designed to accommodate targeted interventions for students requiring extra support and enrichment activities for those who have demonstrated proficiency. After monitoring our processes during the course of the 2023-2024 school year, the only minor change to the schedule for the 2024-2025 school year will be to have three days where the intervention/enrichment time is available for students as opposed to only two days. These days will now be on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays.

At the original time of our request at the beginning of the 2023-2024 school year, we recognized that a small number of our teachers could possibly exceed the Arkansas Department of

Educations' (ADE) 150-student cap set on our "Fast Friday" schedule, although they would have remained within the 30 students per class limit that is also set by the ADE. In light of those observations, the Westside School Board once again approved a resolution that allows me to seek a waiver renewal from the ADE in order to rectify that issue at the June 24 board meeting. The key aspects of that resolution included:

- 1. **Rationale and Problem Addressed:** The waiver acknowledges the importance of "Fast Friday" and the associated homeroom/advisory/intervention/enrichment time. This time allows for targeted interventions and enrichment activities that cater to the diverse needs of our students. The waiver recognizes the special circumstances of co-teaching Special Education classes and the broader benefits of the schedule.
- 2. Services Provided: The schedule structure ensures that all classes receive equitable instructional time. During "Fast Friday," students engage in reviewing Common Formative Assessments and receive additional support or enrichment based on their individual needs. Core teachers (Math, Science, English, Social Studies) will provide targeted interventions for those students who need additional help, while non-core teachers offer a variety of enrichment opportunities for students who have met proficiency in the essential skill or standard being taught.
- 3. **Monitoring and Evaluation:** The effectiveness of this schedule will be continuously monitored and evaluated. Westside High School Department Teams will meet weekly to assess learning targets and student data, while building and district-level goals will be discussed in monthly meetings involving principals, assistant principals, and the district-level Professional Learning Community (PLC) team. Updates on successes and recommendations for improvements will be provided to the superintendent. Formative, summative, and future state-mandated testing data will guide ongoing adjustments in our plan.

Westside High School is committed to making ongoing assessments and adjustments to optimize student learning opportunities, innovation, and equitable access to effective teaching for all of our students. This waiver renewal will offer us the flexibility to do just that. We believe that these initiatives will play a pivotal role in ensuring the academic growth and success of our students. Your support and understanding as valued stakeholders is crucial as we move forward with the PLC processes that will lead to improved student growth and achievement.



This is a notice that we will be seeking the same ACT 1240 waiver as we did in the 23-24 school year. Our school board approved a resolution to be turned in to the Department of Education at last night's board meeting. This officially starts the re-application process.

As a reminder, this waiver addresses class size and teaching load in regards to our master schedule and our "Fast Friday." When we implemented the "Fast Friday" schedule last year, we had a few teachers who had over the 150 student cap on Friday classes. While they did go over the 150 student limit, no one was over the 30 student per class limit. At the time I presented this to the State Board of Education last October, we had 4 teachers on our roster over the 150 limit on the "Fast Friday" days. While we have not started scheduling for the 24-25 school year, the possibility exists that we will have the same issue present itself.

We will be applying for this waiver again for the next 3 years. If you have any questions or concerns, please feel free to reach out to me.


