Upcoming Professional Development Staff Time

Friday, February 13, will be an early dismissal day for students to allow teachers time to work in curriculum teams during the afternoon. Tuesday, February 17, is a scheduled professional development day for teachers and educational assistants. All staff will participate in a suicide prevention presentation led by Ellie Schindeldecker, one of our Lighthouse therapists. Teachers will also have time to collaborate within grade-level or department teams. Educational assistants will receive READ Act training facilitated by Kristie Rahm. In the afternoon, teachers will continue curriculum team work, and EAs will participate in additional READ Act training.

Upcoming concerts include second grade on Thursday, March 12; first grade on April 15 and 16 (afternoons); and kindergarten on April 29 and 30 (afternoons).
