FM (LOCAL)

EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY ABSENCES

The District shall make no distinction between absences for UIL activities and absences for other extracurricular activities approved by the Board. A student shall be allowed in a school year a maximum of ten extracurricular absences not related to post-district competition, a maximum of five absences for post-district competition prior to state, and a maximum of two absences for state competition.

[For eligibility of private school students, including homeschool students, to participate in extracurricular activities, see FD(LOCAL).]

'NO PASS, NO PLAY' WAIVERS

In accordance with UIL rules, a student may receive a waiver of the "no pass, no play" law once each semester for any course that has been identified by the State Board of Education rule as an advanced course. In order to receive such a waiver the following criteria shall also be met:

- 1. Waivers shall be limited to one each semester.
- 2. The failing grade shall be no lower than 60.
- 3. Waivers shall not be granted for the same class twice in the same school year.

USE OF DISTRICT FACILITIES

School-sponsored student groups may use District facilities with prior approval of the appropriate administrator. Other student groups may use District facilities in accordance with policy FNAB.
