**REGULAR SESSION**: President Harding called the regular session to order at 7:00 p.m. Mr. Thacker offered prayer. Mr. Bench led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

**AGENDA, MINUTES**: Mr. Bench moved and Mr. Thacker seconded to approve the agenda, and the minutes of the regular board meeting held January 7, 2021; voting was unanimous in the affirmative.

**RECOGNITION**: E3 and community partner awards were presented to Linda Duncan, Matt Labrum, and Christy Kane for their exceptional contributions and hard work.

**ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS**: The Board reviewed reports from Administration.

### **ACTION ITEMS:**

- 1. <u>School Fees Public Hearing</u> The Board reviewed the schedules of school fees. Public comments are welcomed and another hearing will be held next month.
- 2. <u>Legislative Staff Bonus</u> The Legislature is working on a bonus for staff. Mr. Morrill moved to approve paying all staff when the funds arrive from the Legislature. Mr. Thacker seconded; passed unanimously.
- 3. <u>Property Purchase</u> Property became available adjacent to Union High School. Mr. Morrill moved to approve purchasing the property. Mr. Thacker seconded; passed unanimously.
- 4. <u>Basin Online School Creation</u> More students moved to online education this year and the administration proposed creating a school of record to manage the student information and their education. Those who are completely online would be enrolled there. Those who are partially online and partially attending a school would remain enrolled at the traditional school. Mr. Thacker moved to approve. Mr. Bench seconded; passed unanimously.
- 5. <u>Support for Basin Railroad</u> Pamela Juliano addressed the Board and explained the current comment period of the EIS and requested a letter of support. Mr. Smith moved to approve. Mr. Morrill seconded; Mr. Bench abstained. Motion passed unanimously.
- 6. <u>Driver Education Fee and Pay</u> Mr. Miles reviewed the current pay rates, and fees, and Superintendent Brotherson reviewed other district's rates. Mr. Thacker moved to deny the request for a fee increase. Mr. Morrill seconded; passed unanimously.

#### **DISCUSSION ITEMS:**

1. Superintendent reported the mask requirement is in place through June, and that case numbers are decreasing. The Legislature is looking to change the funding for at-risk students.
