School Board Report February 2016

- 1. Recognition
 - Amanda Lannoye is the high school teacher of the month
- 2. New Programs Update
 - 9th Grade Seminar
 - i. 9th grade seminar utilizes interventions aimed at developing good study and organizational skills, not academic remediation
 - ii. Mrs. Groh coordinates with the other 9th grade subject areas
 - iii. Research shows that 9th grade is a critical year for determining success and likelihood of graduation
 - iv. 1st semester results: Semester failure rate cut in half (2.4% vs 4.5%) and raise the % C- or higher from 85.6% to 89.0%
 - 7th Grade Reading Class
 - i. 80% of the 7th graders will take a Reading 7 class that is one semester in length and based on the Reader's Choice Workshop model
 - ii. This class is a Tier 1 reading intervention aimed at reducing the reading score drop from 6th to 7th grade by raising student lexile scores
 - iii. Mrs. Wagner is the teacher
 - iv. 1st semester results: 71% of the students in the class successfully raised their lexile from the start of the year to the end of the semester.
- 3. 16-17 English Language Arts Staffing Proposal
 - 16-17 English Language Arts Staffing Needs
 - i. Currently 2 overloads
 - ii. Need 1 additional overload because 12th grade is 3 sections
 - Combined .6 FTE
 - iii. Additional programming
 - 1. Create a Reading 8 class to continue raising reading achievement
 - ^{2.} .2 FTE for 16-17
 - 16-17 Additional staffing request of a .8 ELA position
