The Kaufman ISD maintenance team has continued to work on improvement projects around the district. In addition, there were over 330 work orders submitted during the month of May 2025.

Here are just a few of the projects that have recently been completed:



Demolition has begun on several rooms at Monday Elementary. The crew removed several walls (from what once was office space) to make room for new classrooms. Student workers helped the crew by hauling off the debris. The remodel will be complete before school starts again.





In May, the crew was very excited to receive a delivery of new equipment. This shipment included a new front loader and skid steer with attachments.



Following the delivery, the maintenance team immediately got to work on an awning project. The awning will provide some protection for the new assets and help keep them in good working condition for years to come.

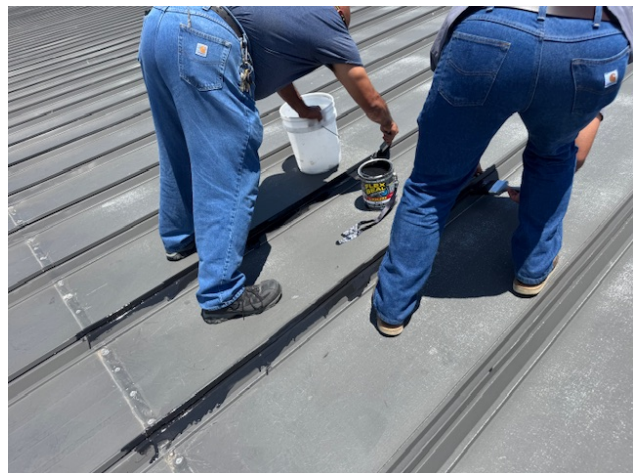

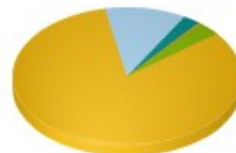
