Greetings from the Foley Public Schools Activities Department,

## **Spring Activities Finish Strong**

- Trapshooting
  - 2025 GRC Team Champions (This was the first year having this event)
  - Foley's Top Individual Finishers - Hunter Peterson of Foley was the top overall finisher for all of the Granite Ridge Conference participants shooting 99 out of 100 total targets. Delayna Ridge took 2nd place honors shooting 97 out of 100 targets, and Ben Trout placed 9th with 94 out of 100 targets. All three athletes received All-Conference Honors
- Boys Tennis
  - The Boys Tennis Team captured their 4th consecutive Section 6A Championship and earned a trip to the Class A Boys State Tennis Tournament. The team went 1-2 at State losing to Rochester Lourdes 6-1, Defeating Redwood Valley 4-3, and losing a highly contested match in the Consolation Championship 4-3 to Southwest Christian.
  - Aaron Vanderweyst and Jack Erkens were the Section 6A Doubles Champions and advanced to the Class A State Doubles Individual Tournament. The duo went 1-1 with a win over Minnewaska Area and a tough 6-4, 7-6 (4) lose to the #1 seeded doubles team from St. Paul Academy and Summit School.
- Track and Field
  - Addison Beier qualified for the Class AA State Track and Field Meet in both the 100 and 200. Addison missed qualifying for the podium by 0.02 seconds in the 200.
  - The 4 x 200 relay team of Sage Greenwalt, Lydia Graham, Olivia Sauer, and Addison Beier also qualified for the Class AA State Track and Field meet and ran well during their relay.
  - Clara Foss qualified for the Class AA State Track and Field Meet in the shot put and also represented Foley very well with all of her throws at State.
