



5. On all flashing that require a termination bar, the contractor is to install sealant behind the term bar, caulking above the term bar
6. Contractor to paint all gas lines per code and color
7. Contractor to re-caulk all ducting that is mounted to the stucco wall and coat all seams and any holes.
8. Contractor to coat all HVAC ducting seams and pan seam
9. ALL roof section of the Pathways building are to be re-roofed and included in the contractors bid. The 219 sq foot roof in the included Eagle View in the SE corner of the building is to be re-roofed with the Garland Rhino Bond system.
