Build on February forecast \$9 million dollar biennium

Because of COVID-19 we are unsure about long-term effects financially

SIA is at risk

Keeping \$1 million in our reserves

PERS are not changing – 6%

Reduced Position

- 2 Certified FTE
 - o 1 Tier 3 Certified FTE
 - 1 High School Teaching FTE
- Hope that class size remains the same, but FCS enrollment has grown
- Enrollment it may continue down
- Most money comes from State School Fund
 - Based on \$9b and each !00m reduction in SSF reduces funding for SSD by \$125,000
 - \circ District must adopt a budget by May 30^{th} not knowing how deeply they will cut the expected funds

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- High School Success \$225,780 funding for 2020-2021
 - Attendance Coordinator

 - Early Warning System

- Possible Cuts would have to be bargained
 - Furlough Days
 - Pay freeze
