Title I, Part A allocation: \$6,769,810 Start / End Dates: 7/01/24 - 9/30/25 IC \$239,516

**Program Intent:** Funding for resources to help schools with high concentrations of students from low-income families provide a high-quality education enabling all children to meet the State's student performance standards.

Title I, Part C allocation: \$270,435 Start / End Dates: 7/01/24 – 9/30/25 IC \$9,568

**Program Intent:** Migrant Education Program funds are designed to support programs which help migrant students overcome the challenges of mobility, cultural and language barriers, social isolation, and other difficulties associated with a migratory lifestyle. These efforts are aimed at helping migrant students succeed in school and successfully transition to postsecondary education or employment.
