ESSA FEDERAL GRANT APPLICATION: PUBLIC COMMENT PROGRAM, ALLOCATION, PROGRAM INTENT, AND PROPOSED USES

Title I, Part A allocation: \$6,769,810 Start / End Dates: 7/01/24 – 9/30/25 IC \$239,516

Program Intent: Funding for resources to help schools with high concentrations of students from low-income families provide a high-quality education enabling all children to meet the State's student performance standards.

Proposed Uses:

- **Salaries-**

Teacher Aides, Instructional Officers, Deans of Instruction, Clerks, Counselors, Curriculum Directors, Secretaries, Media Specialist, Evaluator, ½ Federal Programs Director & Staff, 50% Staff Development /Parent & Family Engagement Director, Service Advocate Recruiters (SARS) 45% and Extra Duty pay for Teachers.

- **Professional & Contracted Services:**

Districtwide staff Development, Consultants, Copier Leases and Phone Service

- **Supplies /Materials and Control Items:**

Campuses, Curriculum Directors, Federal Programs Offices

- **Other Operating Cost:**

Travel and/or Fees & Dues for Media Specialist, Federal Programs Director, Evaluator, Parent & Family Engagement Director, and SARS.

Title I, Part C allocation: \$270,435 Start / End Dates: 7/01/24 – 9/30/25 IC \$9,568

Program Intent: Migrant Education Program funds are designed to support programs which help migrant students overcome the challenges of mobility, cultural and language barriers, social isolation, and other difficulties associated with a migratory lifestyle. These efforts are aimed at helping migrant students succeed in school and successfully transition to postsecondary education or employment.

Proposed Uses:

Migrant Office Staff, 20% for Migrant Counselors

Title II, Part A allocation: \$813,818 Start / End Dates: 7/01/24 – 9/30/25 IC \$28,793

Program Intent: Teacher and Principal Training and Recruiting Funds (TPTR) are designated to supplement staff development in district/campus priority areas, enhance recruiting, hiring, and retention of highly qualified teachers and improve the quality of our principal, teacher, and paraprofessional work force through staff development.

Proposed Uses:

9 Class-Size Reduction Teachers, ½ Staff Development/ Parent & Family Engagement Director

- **Professional & Contracted Services-**

Campus Administrators' Professional Development, Staff Development for Private Non-Profit Campuses

Title III, Part A ELA allocation: \$579,927 Start / End Dates: 7/01/24 – 9/30/25 IC \$11,598

Program Intent: English Language Acquisition, Enhancement, and Academic Achievement Act Funds ensure that English Learner students develop English proficiency and meet the same academic achievement standards other students achieve.

Proposed Uses:

- **Salaries-** SARS 50%, Extended year supplemental English Language Acquisition instruction

- **Staff Development -** Administrators

- **Supplies & Materials-** Campus and District

- **Parental Engagement Activities –** All campuses

EAGLE PASS INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT

Title III, Part A Immigrant allocation: \$19,863 Start / End Dates: 7/01/24 – 9/30/25 IC \$703

Program Intent: Title III, Part A - Immigrant, provides supplemental funds to LEAs who are experiencing substantial increases in immigrant children and youth for activities that provide enhanced instructional opportunities for immigrant children and youth.

Proposed Uses:

- **Supplies & Materials – All Campuses**

Title IV, Part A allocation: \$497,391 Start / End Dates: 7/01/24 – 9/30/25 IC \$17,598

Program Intent: Student Support and Academic Enrichment Grant Funds are designed to improve students' academic achievement by increasing the capacity of the district to provide access to, and opportunities for, a well-rounded education for all students; improve school conditions in order to create a healthy and safe school environment; and improve access to technology in the classroom.
