The summer food service program began June 10th. The summer program will feed breakfast and lunch Monday-Thursday. The new OPI Summer Program Specialist did rescind her approval for the supper program because they stated that we cannot receive (3) reimbursements in a day. We will stay within the guidelines and serve only breakfast and lunch. On Fridays, there will be no meals.

The summer food service program will be serving breakfast and lunch from the Middle School and Browning Elementary kitchens. We will also have a site at the skate park that will serve lunch only. And, we will also have the mobile bus that will serve lunch only to low rent, old low rent, and Starr School site.

The Ware house has been working very hard daily to carry out their daily operations including the assistance they provide for the school kitchens, food deliveries, and mail.

At this time, copy center has finished the end of the school year orders and will be called to work on a "as needed bases," throughout the summer season.

There is a need for some maintenance work and equipment for the Napi kitchen. The Napi kitchen is in vital need of a steam table/warmer and a salad bar server which pictures were previously provided. A packet was given at the foodservice/maintenance board meeting with details on the equipment. At this time, I am waiting on a quote from the equipment company. We have received the quote from the manufacturer.
