

INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN
DUCHESNE COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT
and
DUCHESNE CITY

AGREEMENT made this 28 day of Oct, 2021, by and between the Duchesne County School District, thereafter (The District) and the Duchesne City, hereinafter (The City).

WITNESSETH

Whereas, the District and the City would like to jointly operate property that would serve the students and the community for sports and recreation, and

Whereas, the City has obtained funding through the Permanent Community Impact Fund Board, and

Whereas, the District is willing to pay the financed portion, extra construction, architect / engineering, and legal costs to upgrade the ball fields, and

Whereas, the governing bodies of the parties have approved this Agreement;

Now, therefore, the parties agree that:

1- Terms of Ownership and Construction:

- A. The District is will use the fields for high school sports programs and have scheduling priority for games and practice time. The City will be responsible for the remaining time and scheduling community use.
- B. The District will be responsible for entering into and administering all contracts related to construction.

2- Terms of Operation and Maintenance:

- A. Supervision: Each party is responsible for providing adequate security and supervision for its activities.
- B. Operation: The City will provide water, ^{1/2 RR} fertilizer, and mow the fields.

C. Damage: Each party will be responsible for damage that occurs during the time they are in possession.

3- Terms of Agreement:

A. It is understood that this agreement shall remain in place until the parties shall agree upon mutual termination.
