Academic Progress

Grade levels are conducting middle of year screeners in PreK-2nd grade. Our first graders are also taking the state required dyslexia screener that will be reported at the end of the month. First grade teachers will utilize screener data, plus holistic ratings of spelling, listening comprehension, written expression and penmanship, along with writing samples, to make recommendations to our evaluation team for additional intervention or testing. Students are goal setting as part of the middle of year screening process, to encourage growth and mastery.

Professional development is planned in January to reinforce the 7 Steps to Literacy Rich Classroom as well as best practices in teaching the syllable types and writing in the math classroom. Several of our teachers and staff members are leading a workshop about their work with the 7 Steps, critical thinking in math classrooms, behavior management, Daily 5 and self-care strategies.
