

Minutes of Facility Committee

I. CALL TO ORDER

V. NEW MIDDLE SCHOOL

Summers presented and answered questions regarding an update on the schedule and finances for the Middle School project.

Administration is requesting action on a second batting cage at the new middle school and the electronic gates behind the school. A concept was proposed by administration to implement user fees for the new and existing batting cages.
