

452 Supervision of School Activities and/or Students Outside the School Day
School Board Reviewed: August 17, 2026

I. Students working on any project or activity outside of school hours must be definitely supervised by the teacher in charge of that activity. No activity of any kind is to be in progress unless a teacher is in the presence of the students. This regulation applies to one pupil as well as to a large group. Permission for an activity practice is to be requested. Teachers are not to plan practices without permission from their principal.

II. Teachers in charge of an activity after school are responsible for seeing that all students leave the building. The teacher must be the last one to leave. These rules apply to students who are kept after school for work or discipline. It includes athletic practices of any kind. The custodians are instructed to secure the buildings at 5:00 p.m. each day and after this time a teacher must secure the exit door when he leaves. (Custodians are on duty later than this – depending on the time of the year and school events).
